Rebuilt in 1860, Dauntsey House has been established as a retirement home for over 50 years. The house of character is set in attractive sheltered gardens in a very pleasant village, five miles south of Devizes.

## Accommodation

Public rooms on the ground floor provide ample space for a pleasant social life and there is a colourful conservatory where residents are free to relax and potter.

Guests have their own single room which provides a warm retreat when privacy is preferred. All rooms have emergency call bell system and smoke detector. All rooms are comfortably furnished and fully equipped with central heating, wash basin and TV point. A private telephone can be installed if required. Residents are encouraged to furnish their own rooms with personal belongings to give each room its own individual character.

## Care

We offer both long term and respite care our dedicated trained staff talk to residents and their families to build a person centered care plan to meet individual's needs.

The doctor's surgery is very local and GP will visit when required .The District Nurse is also available when required and we have a chiropodist who visits monthly and weekly visits from the hairdresser.
